

## SUBJECT: 2022 Household and High Need Income Limits

The Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing has approved amendments to Ontario Regulation 370/11 under the *Housing Services Act, 2011* to update the annual Household Income Limits and High Need Income Limits.

The updated Household Income Limits and High Need Income Limits are based on information provided by the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation as required under the Social Housing Agreement, 1999. These new limits came into effect on January 1, 2022.
