




#### **External Engagement To Date:**

- Some were specific to their development applications




### **Wastewater Allocation Area Map**

# AEGD Wastewater Capacity Allocation Capacity and Growth Issues

- Limited Capacity Available over the short term.
- Policies and guidelines for the allocation of this capacity are necessary.



# AEGD Wastewater Capacity Allocation Policy Intent

To manage the provision of wastewater conveyance and treatment capacity in the AEGD drainage catchment to support a growing, prosperous, and healthy community.



# AEGD Wastewater Capacity Allocation Policy Content

- Criteria for assessing project priority
- Requirements to reserve Wastewater Capacity
- A Process for requesting and reserving Wastewater Capacity



# AEGD Wastewater Capacity Allocation Project Priority

Where a conflict occurs between different forms of development, approvals for Wastewater Capacity Allocation will be prioritized generally as follows:

- Non-residential development
- Mixed use developments having predominant Employment uses
- Residential development



# AEGD Wastewater Capacity Allocation Application of the Policy

The following activities in the AEGD drainage area are subject to the Policy:

- development projects submitted under a Planning Act application
- a sewer permit request if not part of a *Planning Act* submission
- a change of use through a building permit application that results in an increase in wastewater demand.



# AEGD Wastewater Capacity Allocation Reserving Wastewater Capacity

- Approval of a development project is not a promise or guarantee of reservation of wastewater capacity allocation.
- Capacity allocation must be granted by the City upon request by an applicant.




#### **Request for Capacity Allocation**

- Upon development approval, the applicant /
  developer must submit a request in writing
  with supporting documentation to receive a
  Letter of Confirmation of Wastewater
  Allocation from the City.
- Wastewater capacity will only be allocated on a Phase or Site-Specific Plan basis; i.e. not upfront for the whole plan.



#### Flow Chart for AEGD Drainage Area Wastewater Allocation Process





#### **Expiry of Capacity Allocation**

Allocation will be reserved up to the expiration date of the City's approval of the application as follows:

- one (1) year for Site Plan and Consent applications; and,
- three (3) years for Subdivision applications;
   and,
- expiration of sewer/building permit.



#### **Request for Extension of Capacity Allocation**

- Capacity Allocation extensions will be considered where the City has granted an extension to approval of a development.
- The extension of will correspond to the length of the extension period of the approved development.



#### **Public Interest Projects**

The City intends to set aside a certain amount of wastewater capacity to projects deemed to be in the best interests of the public including:

- facilities affecting public health and safety
- educational facilities, and
- economic development initiatives.



# AEGD Wastewater Capacity Allocation Policy Control

- Wastewater capacity allocated to a project by the City runs with the land and is non-transferable.
- Staff to actively track the status of capacity allocation vis-a-vis development projects with reporting to Council and the development community.
- This policy shall be reviewed from time to time and amended when deemed necessary by City staff.



# AEGD Wastewater Capacity Allocation Prior to Policy Approval

- FOR Applications that have been submitted but not approved - will include a condition requiring developer to obtain verification of capacity allocation from the City.
- FOR Applications that are conditionally approved

   developer will be required to obtain verification
   of servicing capacity from the City as a
   requirement of servicing design approval.
